Androscoggin Home Healthcare + Hospice is an organization about living, dedicated to enhancing quality of life by providing innovative and compassionate medical care for all. This is our mission – the driving force and motivation for all that we do. While the pandemic has added significant complexities to our work, it has neither changed our focus, nor undermined our purpose. Our talented and dedicated team navigates health care at home – wherever that may be – for 2,700



patients per day in 195 Maine communities. We do so with the compassion for which we are well known, but we also lead the way with the innovation necessary to reimagine healthcare as we know it.

In January of 2021, we launched the Maine Center for Palliative Medicine (MCPM) to be a catalyst in the Maine landscape for the advancement of both the art and science of caring for those with serious illness. Our team of 14 physicians and nurse practitioners, along with a very talented multi-disciplinary team of palliative care professionals have quickly become trusted leaders, educators, and collaborators in advancing best practice for Maine people living with serious and life-limiting health conditions.

For more than 20 years, we have deployed telehealth and remote patient monitoring technology in the homes of thousands of patients. With the pandemic, virtual health technology has become a necessary tool for health care providers. Today we have nearly 600 remote patient monitoring units deployed on any given day with nurses collecting data from individual patients to manage symptoms, prevent unnecessary hospital admissions, decrease emergency department utilization where appropriate, monitor outbreak facilities, and assist medical providers with managing medication adjustments and other medical interventions. Patients as young as 95 years of age use the technology with ease, and satisfaction rates exceed 97 percent.

While grief may be the price we pay for having loved deeply, it need not be navigated alone. We have invested in bereavement services for families who experience the loss of a child at birth; youth who experience loss, especially in these pandemic times; and family support following the death of a patient on our services. Growth of bereavement services and expertise within the communities we serve has been achieved with grant dollars and the tremendous support of the communities we serve.

These are but a few examples of our commitment to offer innovative health care services in the home setting while collaborating with our partners in hospitals, facilities, and medical offices across Maine. We are grateful for opportunities to innovate in ways that improve the quality of life for those we serve, and we are proud of the compassionate roots from where such innovation is derived.

Androscoggin experienced steady growth across all programs of our organization including Home Health, Hospice, and Palliative Care. In 2021, Androscoggin had the privilege to provide service to 12,167 patients across our communities in all program areas, which was a slight decrease of one percent from 2020. We provided 250,646 visits in 2021 compared to 221,486 in 2020, or a 13 percent increase year over year.

Our growth this year created a positive bottom line, which allows us to reinvest in the organization, our employees, and most importantly – the patients and families to which we provide excellent service. Our focus on diversifying our revenue base through innovation while carefully monitoring our expenses is critical to our financial stability and has proved to be a strength of Androscoggin's growth strategies. Our financial sustainability supports our vision to enrich the quality of life through the best care that ultimately benefits our patients and families experience with Androscoggin, allowing us to provide these services regardless of their ability to pay or the cost of their care. This vision allows us to provide free care to 1,071 patients equating to \$1.64 million.



Revenue and Expenses Analysis Fiscal year ended December 31, 2021.



Butterfly Release Celebration

Androscoggin's annual Butterfly Release Celebration was held virtually on Saturday, July 24. Participants were able to be part of the moving family tradition through our website and Facebook page to watch the ceremony, hear loved ones' names read aloud, and watch the symbolic release of beautiful butterflies. Serving as a reminder that life lives on following the death of a loved one, garden butterflies were placed outside of Androscoggin administrative offices and the Androscoggin Hospice House throughout the week of July 19–25. As an additional component for 2021, butterfly window decals were sent with each butterfly dedication purchased. Each gift to the Butterfly Release Celebration benefits the Androscoggin Hospice House.

Hike for Hospice

Reimagined from its initial inception as a 5k, participants formed teams to celebrate the lives and memories of loved ones, raised critical resources, and moved virtually at their own pace with their location and activity of choice - hiking, biking, swimming, and more - between May 10 and May 21. For our younger hikers, a StoryWalk featuring the book "Tear Soup: A Recipe for Healing After Loss" was on display at the YMCA Outdoor Learning and Education Center in Auburn. Resources raised through Hike for Hospice directly support Androscoggin's hospice program, ensuring that all Mainers have access to quality hospice care.







Autumn Night Out

In celebration of its 18th year, Autumn Night Out was able to return to an in-person event, outdoors and under the stars, on September 10 at the beautiful Poland Spring Resort. As Androscoggin's signature event comprised of dinner, an auction, and fireworks, Autumn Night Out has raised more than \$600,000, supporting compassionate and dignified end-of-life

care for hospice patients and their families. Each year's event includes a special paddle raise devoted to an immediate need. This year, donors supported Androscoggin's Bereavement Support programs, offered free of charge to help people cope with grief following the loss of a loved one.

Androscoggin's Hospice House Has a New Kitchen – Karen's Kitchen

One of the great resources within the Lewiston-Auburn Community is Androscoggin's Auburn Hospice House. Opened in 2005 as the first freestanding hospice house of its kind in the state of Maine, the Hospice House has served more than 7,000 patients and their families. In 2020, Androscoggin recognized that time had laid its hands on the kitchen within the house, and set about with plans to completely renovate it as the first stage of multiphase program to refresh the Hospice House in its entirety.

Understanding that the kitchen is the heart of every home, Androscoggin's Foundation Committee of its Board of Directors recognized that the organization could not complete this project alone and set in motion what was to become the most successful campaign Androscoggin has undertaken since the Hospice House's Building Campaign in 2005. Chaired by Foundation Committee members, Mary and David MacMahon and Foundation Chair, Paul Andersen, they rallied the support of individuals, businesses, Androscoggin's own employees, foundations, and organizations both near and far in support of this vital renovation project for Androscoggin's hospice patients and their families.

Launched with great fanfare at the 2020 Autumn Night Out benefit and behind a lead gift from Androscoggin's Hospice House Dream Team, the

Community Capital Campaign to Renovate the Androscoggin Hospice House Kitchen was off to the races. Among the many enhancements planned were upgrades to patient accessibility, environmental safety, and the addition of a self-serve service area for patients and families.

In December, as the finishing touches were being placed on the newly remodeled kitchen, the Campaign Chairs announced that not only did this community-wide fundraising effort obtain its goal, but had surpassed it with more than 320 donors! More importantly, with this milestone achieved, it was also announced that the newly renovated kitchen and dining area would be named Karen's Kitchen in honor of Karen Flynn, RN, who retired from Androscoggin in 2020 as the Director of Hospice and Palliative Care after a 30-year nursing career. Karen was the first clinical house manager when the house opened in 2005, as well as a beloved state-wide hospice advocate.

It is with an enormous sense of gratitude that we recognize the more than 320 donors, who through their thoughtful and kind investments have not only renovated this wonderful community resource, but also have improved the future quality of our patients and families experience.



Experiences Significant Growth in 2021

Palliative medicine is specialized care that anticipates, identifies and treats physical, emotional, and spiritual discomfort in people with serious or terminal illness. With serious and terminal illness having a high prevalence in older adults, the demand for palliative services in Maine has seen rapid growth, as the average age of Mainers continues to increase. Maine Center for Palliative Medicine (MCPM) swiftly expanded clinical services this year to meet the communities' needs. In 2021, MCPM served close to 700 unique individuals; at the end of the year, the program was averaging a daily census of 250 patients.

Since the inception of palliative medicine at Androscoggin in 2017, the organization has invested significant clinical resources to the growth of this program. What started with two providers has grown to a staff of eight physicians and five nurse practitioners, and will soon be introducing social work services.

This robust clinical staff is dually trained in hospice and palliative care, providing palliative care for Androscoggin's community program, two local hospitals, and a newly launched outpatient clinic. In addition to their extensive palliative care work, the provider group is responsible for medical oversight of Androscoggin's large home hospice program and attending care at Androscoggin's 14-bed Hospice House.

Maine Center of Palliative Medicine staff invite you to join them in celebrating significant successes from 2021:

 Since March, the team has leveraged predictive analytics and a thorough chart review by the Palliative Care Nurse Clinical Coordinator to proactively identify and engage patients who may benefit from receiving palliative care services. The value of this work was further recognized with a grant from the Davis Family Foundation for \$25,000 to fund the continuation of this work in 2022.

- In September, MCPM launched their first outpatient palliative medicine clinic, located in Lewiston, Maine on the St. Mary's Regional Medical Center campus.
- The program has experienced more than 30 percent growth in the number of individuals served annually (from 2020 to 2021), with 99.3 percent growth in the number of individuals served monthly (from January 2021 to November 2021).
- The creation of MCPM coupled with the program's exponential growth inspired the hiring (promotion) of the first ever Maine Center for Palliative Medicine Practice Manager, Brianne Genschel. Also hired to further ensure the smooth operation of our booming program was Julie Daniels, LSW, Palliative Care Coordinator.
- The development of the MCPM Nurse Practitioner Fellowship Program. The Program is currently accepting applications for its first year, with the fellowship anticipated to be launching in July 2022.
- Actively participate in the Palliative Care Quality Collaborative, which collects information on palliative care outcomes, establishes national standards, and informs research and quality improvement.

A special thank you to program leadership and staff whose compassion, integrity, and excellence has made these accomplishments possible. As the Maine Center for Palliative Medicine prepares for 2022, the energy and excitement of what lies ahead is palpable.

While it is our great privilege to accept and thank your generosity, it is also our pleasure to inform you that the resources you have entrusted to us are providing the greatest benefit possible to those we serve.

Among the highlights of our past fundraising year, I am thrilled to report, as one of the Co-Chairs of this effort, that our Community Campaign to Renovate the Hospice House Kitchen - named Karen's Kitchen, in honor of Karen Flynn - surpassed its goal of \$309,000.

Since the Hospice House opened in 2005, more than 7,000 patients and families have been cared for in the house. We are eternally grateful to all the individuals and organizations who so



generously made gifts to this vital effort; know that your generosity has and will make a real and important difference for those we serve.

Additionally, this past year we were able to return in-person to our Autumn Night Out Benefit Auction, which raised more than \$100,000 while \$25,000 of which was designated for Androscoggin's Bereavement Services. In 2021, Androscoggin also awarded three \$2,000 scholarships from its newly created Julie Shackley Memorial Scholarship Fund held in our Long Term Mission Endowment. As many will recall, Julie was a nurse and educator, and served as the CEO and President of Androscoggin from 2005–2013. It is gratifying to know her passion lives on.

No report of gifts and giving would be complete if we did not express our deepest gratitude to the individual clinicians who travel millions of miles each year in service to our patients and families. Employees Support Good Shepherd Food Bank

Androscoggin is fortunate to receive generous support from individuals, corporate partners, and foundations throughout our community. Because of this generosity, we are able to continue to provide high quality care to all – regardless of age or ability to pay. It is in this spirit of giving that Androscoggin also seeks to give back to the communities we serve.

Each year, Androscoggin employees choose a local nonprofit organization that aligns with our mission, vision, and values. Throughout the year, employees raise funds, volunteer, and collect in-kind donations where applicable. Past AndroGIVES partners have included Trinity Jubilee Center, New Beginnings, Androscoggin Humane Society, and Travis Mills Foundation. Since the program's inception, employees have donated their time and funds totaling \$11.616.

Androscoggin employees enthusiastically selected Good Shepherd Food Bank as the mission to eliminate hunger in Maine by improving access to nutritious food for people in need, building strong community partnerships, and mobilizing the public in the fight to end hunger. In addition to distributing food to Mainers in need, Good Shepherd leads a statewide effort to combat the root causes of hunger by engaging in advocacy, nutrition education, and strategic partnerships. Through the kindness and generosity of Androscoggin employees, \$2,164 was distributed to Good Shepherd in addition to nonperishable food items collected through food drives throughout the year.









Bereavement Program

The Bereavement Department at Androscoggin Home Healthcare + Hospice has many offerings for children, teens and adults. They are offered throughout the year and are available to patients and their families as well as anyone in the community. There is never a charge for our bereavement services.

Adult offerings include "Guidance through Grief" groups: an eight-week general grief group for adults who have lost a loved one. We share stories, pictures, and fond memories in a safe and confidential setting. The eight-week groups are offered three times a year, in-person and virtually. We also offer "Restorative Retelling," a ten-week grief support group for those who have lost a loved one in a traumatic way such as suicide, drug overdose, murder, automobile accidents and more. This group utilizes hands-on activities and relies on the concept of Post-Traumatic Growth. We occasionally offer a virtual grief book club "Grieving Between the Lines," that serves as a gentler way to support adults who are not yet ready to attend a group in person or speak directly about their grief.



August of 2021 marked the seventh year for "Camp **Dragonfly,"** a daylong grief camp for children ages six to 17 and their parents or guardians. It has been made possible, due in large part, to the generous people at Tripp Lake Camp in Poland, Maine. Staffing for the camp includes our social workers, nurses, chaplains, bereavement department, and volunteers. We use art, crafts and music to help families learn healthy coping and communication skills. There are no words to describe the healing that is witnessed at Camp Dragonfly.

Meals & Memories occurs every year around the holidays. It is open to all ages who have experienced the loss of a loved one. Attendees bring their loved one's favorite meal. Everyone delights in sharing the memories these meals represent. The day also includes crafting in honor of loved ones who are missed, especially during this time of year.

We also have books available for children and teens who have experienced a loss. When Someone Dies: A *Child-Caregiver Activity Book* is produced by The National Alliance for Children's Grief, formerly known as the National Alliance for Grieving Children. This is a thoughtful book that provides grief support to children and the adult accompanying them through their grief. Our selection of books not only support young people with grief after a loved one dies but can also be utilized after a traumatic event.

New York Life Foundation and The National Alliance for Children's Grief recently awarded the bereavement department a \$25k grant for our children's programming. We are excited about the many things this generous gift facilitates. We have plans for a once-amonth movie event "Projections of Grief." Families will be invited to watch a movie with an element of grief in its content. Popcorn and drinks will be served and discussion will follow the movie. We will also be hosting "The Art of Grief," a monthly grief art activity. All of the supplies will be sent to registrants and a video will be available online that will detail how to create the project and talk about the loss during the activity. Being able to ship these activities kits all over the state will remove one of the barriers of getting grief support to children and teens, even in the most remote areas in the state.

We will be offering a grief-and-loss support group to young people who are involved with New Beginnings, a support organization for children, teens and young adults who don't have stable family support and are at risk for homelessness. This group of young people experience many types of loss. Supporting them can positively affect their chances of success in their journey.

Through Coalition for Grieving Children & Teens, we educate our communities and have a central location to collect information about children's grief programming, which allows us to get our services to the kids in need.

All of our children's programming is made possible thanks to the National Alliance for Children's Grief, The New York Life Foundation, Tripp Lake Camp, and the many generous donors who pledged funds at our paddle raise event during our Autumn Night Out.


